Secondary School Certificate Annual Examination, 2022

The Secondary School Certificate Part-I&II Annual Examinations, 2022 were conducted from May 10th, 2022 to June 11th, 2022 within the territorial jurisdiction of Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, Lahore. Prior to conducting the said examinations, BISE Lahore had taken important steps and made necessary arrangements for the successful conduct of the examinations in accordance with the instructions of the Higher Education Department as well as the SOPs of Board's Examination System. The Board imparted training to the supervisory staff especially the Superintendents, Deputy Superintendents and Distributing Inspectors through Training Workshops so that the examinations could be conducted in a befitting manner. By making these arrangements properly, the examinations were conducted smoothly and peacefully in all the districts of Lahore Division viz. Lahore, Kasur, Sheikhupura and Nankana Sahib. Four Control Rooms were also set up at each district level by BISE Lahore to monitor the examination activities and deal with any unpleasant situation during the examinations.



Supervisory staff from the different examination centers including 13 Superintendents, 04 Deputy Superintendents, 05 Invigilators, 01 Distributing Inspector and 02 Resident Inspectors were removed from the examination duties by the Mr. Najaf Iqbal, Secretary (Higher Education Department)/Board Administrator due to negligence in the performance of examination.



Examination Monitoring

All examination centers were closely monitored to make the examination system transparent. Conducive environment was provided to the candidates in the examination centers so that they could solve the question papers according to their ability.

In order to crush the cheating mafia, Section 144 of the Pakistan Penal Code was implemented at all examination centers. All unauthorized persons were prohibited from entering the examination centers.



In this regard, Mr. Najaf Iqbal, Secretary, Higher Education Department, Punjab and Dr. Mirza Habib Ali, Chairman, BISE Lahore conducted surprise visits on various examination centers during the examinations of Secondary School Certificate (Annual) 2022.

The Secretary, Higher Education Department, Punjab Mr. Najaf Iqbal visited the cluster center of Punjab University where thousands of candidates were taking the examination simultaneously. He also visited the examination centers of Lahore College for Women University, Lahore where he instructed the examination staff to display the appointment cards around the neck Issued by the Board Authorities. The examination staff at Lahore College for Women University, Lahore was also found negligent in their examination duty and an immediate order was issued to remove this staff. Secretary, Higher Education ordered the Controller of Examinations, BISE Lahore that if any mobile was found in the possession of examination staff during the examination that staff would be removed from the examination duty and strict action should be taken against them. The Secretary HED was accompanied by Dr. Rehana Ilyas, Additional Secretary (Boards) and Mr. Khalid Parvez, Additional Secretary (Establishment).

Paper Marking of SSC/HSSC (Annual) Examination, 2022

Marking of Answer Scripts of the Secondary School and Intermediate (Annual) Examinations, 2022 is going on and for that matter, the Board has constituted 20 Marking Centers for SSC and 17 Marking Centres for Intermediate Examinations in Lahore Division, i.e. (District Lahore, Kasur, Sheikhupura and Nankana Sahib).



Approximately, 42,29,416 answer scripts of the SS (Annual) Examination and 22,77,248 answer scripts of Intermediate (Annual) Examination will be marked within schedule time. Currently, marking is being done by the teachers appointed by the Board according to the rules. The Chairman, BISE Lahore inspects the marking centres with regular intervals and discusses the standards of marking with the examiners. He urged that marking of the scripts may be done in consonance with the marking instructions.
